In 2011, I have declared it as the "Year of the Next Generation". We have to be looking to the future for not only the Club, but this wonderful hobby that we are involved in. The kids will learn automotive safety, how to properly handle tools, how to identify tools, how to use tools, how to restore parts, how to spray paint from cans, how to be cautious when assembling a painted car, and lots more based on their

availability and attendance. So if you have someone that fits into this category, have them, or you call me for more info. There will be award incentives for the kids as they attend these sessions. Dates and times are flexible depending on the kids and parents schedule. All schedules are workable.

Christmas time is approaching and our party is set for the 11<sup>th</sup> of December at 6:00 (dinner at 7) at the Grand International on the top of North Hill. Before the 1<sup>st</sup> of December the cost is only \$20 per person. After that date, the cost per person is \$25.00.
